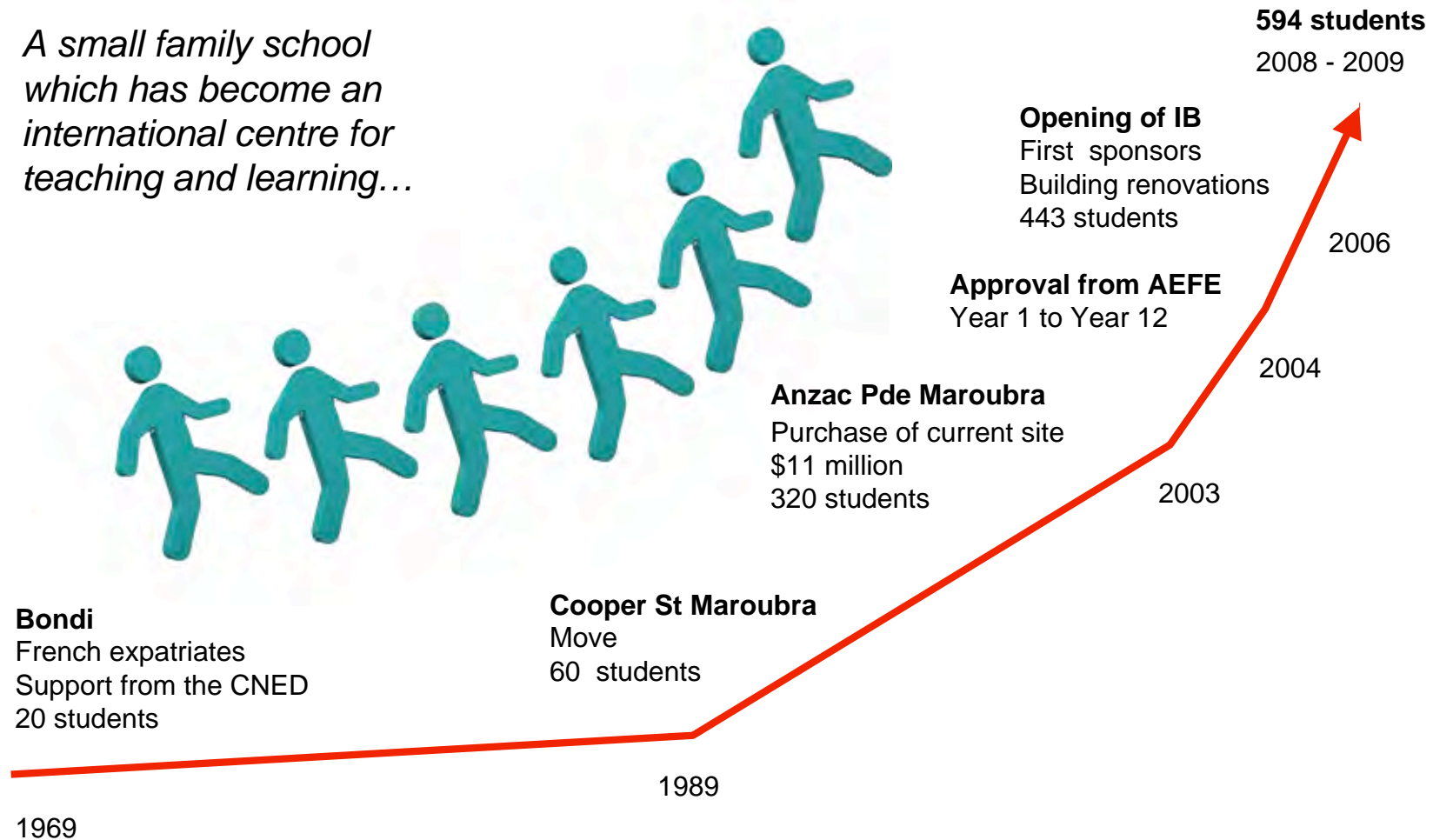

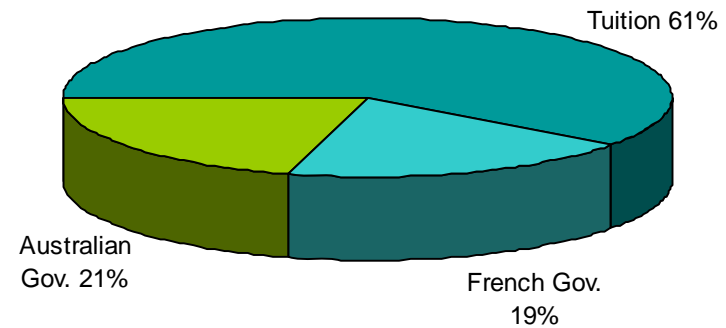

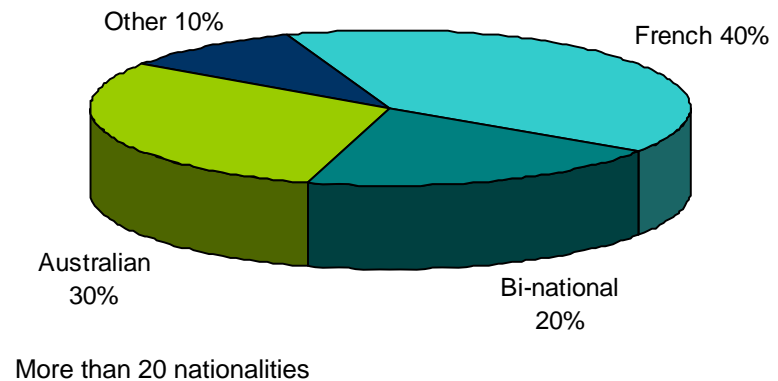

Our Vision

Creativity, an active critical mind and an understanding of the world around us are all essential skills for the 21st Century

- Research has shown that learning several languages from a young age increases a child's cognitive skills, especially verbal expression skills, creativity and the ability to find solutions to complex problems.
- When immersed in a diversified cultural environment where they learn to better understand and appreciate other cultures, young people develop heightened relationship, communication and adaptation skills.
- At Condorcet, we believe that the conjunction of an analytical mind with the rigour of the French education system builds these skills, skills which are indispensable to understand and function in tomorrow's world.

Our Mission

Training responsible citizens who are well prepared and ready to go out into the adult world with confidence

- The International French School of Sydney trains its students to be responsible citizens, open to diversity and conscious of their environment, ready to succeed in a world which has become increasingly complex and multicultural.
- Teaching, based on the academic excellence and continuity of the French Education System, as well as on languages, is enhanced by elements of the Australian curriculum taught in English. A diversified cultural and artistic initiative is also part of the program.
- Thanks to the depth of this bicultural and bilingual system, our students are prepared for the high demands of tertiary studies, whether they be in French or English.

Our Strategic Objectives

- To ensure excellence in teaching and learning
- To develop an authentic “Condorcet Culture”
- To create a brand name and communicate the strengths of our teaching and learning philosophy
- To manage growth in a rapidly changing environment
- To finance the investments in infrastructures and equipment that are critical to the quality of the learning environment and to the development of the Lycée.

Our Action Plan – Primary areas of Investment

Marketing:

- Internal and external communication.
- Recruitment of students for the IB, retention of English-speaking students in Secondary school.

Pedagogy:

- Language skills.
- Support on an individual basis.
- Cultural and artistic programmes.
- Programmes related to nutrition, health and the environment.

Site and infrastructure:

- Improvements to the buildings and the physical school environment.
- New classrooms and an expanded space in the canteen.
- Cultural and sporting infrastructure.
- Teaching equipment: Library, information technology, science laboratory.

Project 1: Canteen & Health

The canteen at the International French School of Sydney was awarded a prize for the best school canteen in 2006 (Scolarest) as well as a nomination for 2008. Whilst respecting traditional culinary practices, the canteen offers nutritious and varied menus, mindful of dietary requirements and maintaining strict controls on meals for children with allergies.



The International French School of Sydney would like to optimise this space:

- Extension of the canteen to serve up to 800 meals a day: improvement of equipment such as the cold room, freezer, storeroom, ovens, industrial food processors...
- Programmes related to nutrition and health.
- Sustainable development project: waste management and recycling.



Project 2: Science & Technology

In order to create an area dedicated to training future scientists and engineers, the French School intends to upgrade its Science and Technology department.



- Create a new laboratory EXAO (Computer-aided experiments). This would be a multi-disciplinary laboratory oriented towards Physics, Chemistry, and Earth Sciences.
- Purchase measuring equipment (Chemistry and Physics), computers, Interactive Whiteboards.
- Enhance the existing working environment by the modernisation and renovation of classrooms.



Project 3: Sport & Recreation

Sport is another way in which a child's personality can develop, learning through physical activity and building an understanding of team spirit and dynamics.



- The creation of a multi-sport court: Handball, Volleyball, Tennis.
- The installation of a new surface covering for the primary school playground

Other Projects

Building & Environment

- Building works.
- Full landscape design including an eco-garden.
- Water harvesting, renewable energies and building efficiency into our systems.

Library

- Installation of new shelving.
- Purchase of software.

Information Technologies

- Upgrading of computer systems & hardware.
- Purchase of educational software.
- Installation of fibre optic network throughout the school.

School Hall

- Improvements to the Hall.
- Purchase of a new piano and musical instruments.
- Lighting, audio & video equipment.

Financing Condorcet

History

- The French Government: contribution of capital of \$5M to purchase the school premises in 2003.
- The NSW State Government extended generous terms of sale (to the value of \$3M) for the purchase of the current premises
- Companies: sizeable one-off contributions in 2006:
 - » BNP \$150 000
 - » Société Générale \$125 000
 - » Australian Aerospace \$20 000
- Donations in kind by various organisations, companies or individuals (gardens, supplies, computer equipment)

Objectives for 2008/2009

- Launch of a fundraising campaign in partnership with both French and Australian companies.
