Approved by the French Education Ministry and the NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA), the school is looking for a **Part-time English Teacher (9 to 16h/week) in Junior & Senior Secondary School to start on 15 August 2019.**

As part of the pedagogical team, the teacher will:

- Strengthen the teaching of the English language at the school;
- Collaborate with members of the English teaching department;
- Ensure all students acquire a recognised level of the English language as required by the NSW and French curriculums;
- Teach the English curriculum to students in secondary school (Years 6-12);
- Fulfil all associated and necessary teaching duties and other duties as determined by the Principal.

Working under the authority of the Principal, the candidate will:

- Hold a teaching degree from an Australian education system (or other English speaking education systems), or a teaching degree from the French education system;
- Have a successful work experience teaching Year 11 and Year 12 students;
- Have a proven practice in the delivery of the Junior Secondary curriculum;
- Be able to adapt their teaching to the students' needs;
- Show a real ability to work as part of a team and in a bilingual culture;
- Preferably have an attested B1/B2 level in the French language;
- Have full working rights;
- Have a current Working with Children Check Clearance or be willing to obtain one prior to employment;
- Have current Child Protection training and First Aid Certificates – desirable;
- Be accredited with NSW Education Standards Authority (NESA).

Salary:
