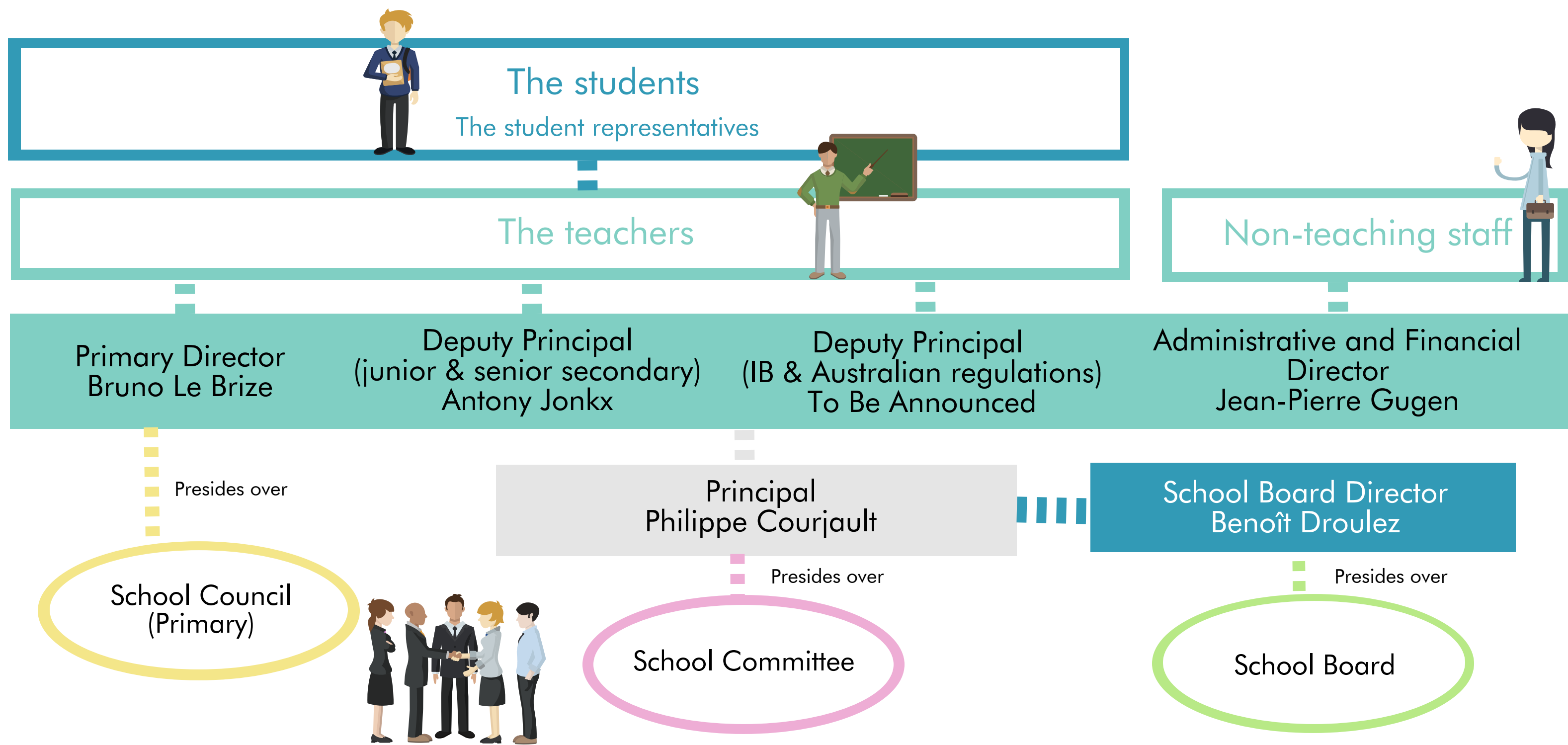


Lycée Condorcet Organisational Chart
