The instrumental Course Overview and fees

It has been proven through countless studies that the benefits of learning to play a musical instrument and having a quality music education are beyond a shadow of a doubt vital to improve the cognitive development of a growing creative mind. It naturally feeds their creativity while instilling important values such as hard work, dedication, perseverance, problem solving, team work, sense of achievement, self-confidence and above all fun!

- **Individual lessons**
Students are given the opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument one on one with a professional instrument tutor. These lessons are 30 minutes in duration.
- **Duos –Octets**
These lessons are offered for specific instruments. Violin/strings, flute, saxophone, clarinet, percussion and guitar.
- **Ensemble performance classes:**
Specially trained conductors will teach the ensemble classes to students wanting to expand their musical horizons by entering the rewarding new world of ensemble performance!

Instrument lessons (30 minutes)

- Semester 1
Lessons will commence on **September 3rd 2018** and finish on **December 14th 2017 (13 teaching weeks)**.

Group lessons of 6 students or more are only offered to students already receiving solo instrument lessons in the program.

Choir lessons (60 minutes)

Choir is on Fridays at 3.25-4.20 for CP CE1 and 4.30-5.30 for CE2-CM2 students.

Other information

Instrumental lessons are paid in advance at the time of enrolment through Eduka and will be invoiced by the school twice per year. The lessons will be invoiced with the AES and other extra-curricular activities.
